Millicent Bridgman (Mrs John S) was a lifelong resident of Fairfield.

Scope and content note:

The two scrapbooks in this collection were created by Millicent Bridgman between 1936 and 1946. One consists primarily of clippings concerning marriages, engagements, and deaths, including those of soldiers in World War II. The other is a collection of articles about historic structures and events in Fairfield. Loose clippings from the back of volume 2 and additional loose clippings accompanying the volumes have been copied onto alkaline paper and placed in folders.
