Biographical/ historical note:

Charles Gilman, a Bridgeport lawyer, constructed his house on the ridge parallel to Main Street in Southport between 1871-1874. The building is a fine example of the "Stick Style" of architecture, in which the decoration on wall faces and gable ends reflects the building's internal structure. In spirit it resembles a Swiss Chalet. For more information about this style, see Southport: the Architectural Legacy of a Connecticut Village by Jan Cigliano and Ralph Schwarz.

Gilman used the services of two New York architects, J. C. Cady and William H. Beers, to design the house and the later library addition, respectively. Both architects has offices on Broadway in New York City. The addition, built about 1900, continues the architectural style of the original structure.

Scope and content note:

The collection consists of floor plans, details, and elevations in blue print and ink on linen, for the Gilman house and the later library addition. The plans have been organized in chronological order, followed by a copy of the mason and carpenter's specifications for the renovations and addition planned by Beers.
