Biographical/historical note:

The building which houses the Pequot Library, designed by H. H. Richardson, was erected in 1887, personally financed by Mr. and Mrs. E. B. Monroe who lived on the site. The Monroes envisioned the building as a library, reading room, lecture hall, and "something in the nature of a social headquarters." A library association formed in 1893 with the purpose of overseeing management of the organization. The building opened to the public in 1894. The library is known for its rare book collection, including Audubon elephant folios, Civil War materials, current fiction and non-fiction, its three stained-glass windows and its homey atmosphere. Portions of the material in this collection were donated by the historian of the Southport Congregational Church along with other Southport memorabilia. Items that were "gathered" for the vertical file were removed to this collection to ensure their preservation.

Scope and content note:

The collection consists primarily of tickets and small broadsides advertising lectures, concerts and other events held at the Pequot Library Hall, 1894-1939, 1953, 1980-84. Other items of note include a list of subscribers to the Southport Library, 1877; correspondence, 1894-1896, 1916, 1937-1971 (scattered), the earliest of which concern the construction of the library building; and drawings of the seating plan in library hall, n.d., a pencil sketch of stack arrangements, n.d., and a blueline drawing of book shelving placement, 1953. Also included among the materials are bills, 1895-1897; newsletters, 1970-1987; and assorted publications.
