Biographical/ historical note:

Henry John Stegeman (1828-1898) and his wife Augusta Schmidt (1836-1916) owned a farm in the Holland Hill District (Jennings Road) of Fairfield in the 1890s. Both were born in Germany. Augusta's father was Elias Schmidt (1805-1889). Henry and Augusta had children Charles (1858-1938), Emma (1864-1954), Eva (1867-1962), Anna Marie (1868-1953), Bertha (1872-73), Henry John Jr. (1873-1961), and Dora Martha (1880-1907). Emma and Eva never married, and evidently lived on the family farm. Dora married Edward H. Higley and they had a daughter Gennevia. Gennevia married Frederick P. Schmidheini; their sons were Edwin (the donor of portions of the collection) and Laurence. The Langer family was related by marriage. For additional information, see the family group sheets and pedigree chart in the collection folder.

Scope and content note:

The collection is arranged by relationship of the family members whose photographs comprise the bulk of the material. Immediate members of the Stegeman family are arranged in series by birth order. Henry J. Stegeman, Sr., as the patriarch, is listed first. Included with his photographs are some financial papers, a quitclaim deed for land in Fairfield, 1875, photographs of his wife Augusta, and photographs and a German passport, 1850, for Elias Schmidt (Augusta's father). Henry's children are then arranged in order of their birth, each with their own series. Of particular interest are German taufscheins (birth certificates) signed in Bridgeport for Eva, Bertha and Dora. Eva's papers also include a letter from missionary Charles Ewing in Tientsin, China in 1895; pictures of the Wynona Bicycle Club, of which she was president; a membership card in the League of American Wheelmen, 1899; materials relating to the Faith Congregational Chapel, 1894-1927, in which she was an active member; and a license to carry a gun, 1907. Henry Stegeman Jr.'s papers include legal papers relating to an act of replevin against his wife, 1905, and a program for a meeting of the Bridgeport I.O.O.F. in 1930.

The Series entitled Related Stegeman Families Papers include a photograph album; a memoranda book with birth, marriage and death dates for family members; a paper napkin with Lillie Ross's name inscribed in pencil, 1899; and photographs of the Langer family, the family doctor Donovan and the Stegeman homestea on Jennings Road. Additional photographs represent identified as well as unidentified family and friends. Memoranda within this series include a list of "gifts,"1916; an estate inventory, n.d.; New Year's greetings from Samuel Morehouse, 1897; and greeting cards. In the printed materials are a history of the Fairfield County Farm Bureau, postcards, and a 1900 Bridgeport almanac.
