Biographical/ historical note:

Robert McGregor, born in Scotland, was the head gardener on the Annie B. Jennings estate, Sunnie Holme. He worked there from 1914 until Annie B. Jennings' death in 1939. According to her will, her Judson Street property was to be sold to Robert McGregor for \$1.00. The house on this property was likely the caretaker's house and as such was occupied by McGregor and his family already.

Scope and content note:

This collection largely consists of images of Robert McGregor and the gardens of Sunnie-Holme, photographs and postcards. There are also a few documents related to the end of McGregor's employment as gardener upon the death of Annie B. Jennings and the transfer of the Judson Street property to him.
