## **BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL NOTE**

This Couch family settled in Fairfield in the middle of the 17th century. As the collection indicates, these were people of property. Many of the items belonged to Simon Couch (1729-1809) who settled in Green's Farms and was a farmer, merchant, town official and tax collector. His daughter Abigail married William Sherwood. ## **SCOPE AND CONTENTS NOTE**

This collection consists of one box containing bills, correspondence, deeds, financial records and legal papers, real estate papers, wills, Yale school papers and ledgers. Of particular note is Folder K with indenture servant and slave papers. There are two oversize items: Simon Couch, Jr.'s Practical Survey Work Book and a genealogy of the Couch family.

The deeds, misc. ledgers and writs are listed by date. All other categories are alphabetized.
