

Volunteer Junior Docents (Summer 2024)

The Fairfield Museum Junior Docent Program provides a unique opportunity for regional high school students to work with families and children in an educational setting. Junior Docents will develop important public speaking skills while learning about and sharing the history of Fairfield. For Summer Saturdays on the Museum Commons (June 1-August 31, 2024), Junior Docents will lead brief tours and facilitate hands-on activities for children in the historic properties on the Museum Commons. The historic properties include: The Victorian Cottage (1888), the Victorian Barn (1888), and the Sun Tavern (c. 1780).

Who Can Apply?

- You must be at least 14 years old and have completed 8th grade to be eligible for this opportunity.
- Teens are not required to live in Fairfield, but you must have a reliable means of transportation to and from the Fairfield Museum for training, meetings, and volunteering sessions.
- Accepted students will be required to complete a training session to learn about history and develop public speaking skills.
- Safety procedures will also be covered in the training.
- This opportunity qualifies for community service requirements.

What skills do I need?

Junior Docents should:

- have a passion for history and learning;
- be able to work with different audiences, including adults, families, and children;
- have good communication skills, respect for multiple points of view and a willingness to encourage others to share;
- Be able to walk or stand for long periods.

What is the commitment?

- Attend required training sessions, to be determined at a later date.
- Read and study materials on history and education.
- Commit to volunteering to a minimum of 2 shifts per month. Shifts are Saturdays from 11 am 2 pm,
 June 1 August 31, 2024. Note that Junior Docents should plan to arrive about 15 minutes prior to the start of their shift and be available to assist with clean-up if needed.

How to Apply

Students interested in applying for the Junior Docent Summer 2024 opportunity should fill out a Junior Docent Volunteer Application and submit it along with all supplemental materials. Priority will be given to applications submitted by <u>May 3, 2024</u>.
