Teach at the Museum!

The Fairfield Museum and History Center seeks creative and enthusiastic teachers who have a passion for helping children discover and explore the arts, history and culture.

Teachers are invited to submit proposals for after school classes and/or summer camps at the Fairfield Museum. Class themes may include drawing, painting, collage, photography, multimedia and photography and should utilize the Museum's exhibitions and collections as inspiration. Teachers are also encouraged to take advantage of the historic and natural sites surrounding the Fairfield Museum, including exhibitions in the 1780 Sun Tavern and the Kids Cottage as well as Ash Creek, Jennings Beach, and the Burr Mansion gardens.

Teachers are responsible for developing lesson plans, games, songs, and hands-on activities that actively engage children ages 5 – 12. Must be able to demonstrate an excellent and diverse teaching history. Connecticut teaching certificate a plus.

After school classes take place for 1 ½ - 2 hours once a week for 4 – 6 week sessions. Summer Camp teachers develop themes and activities for half day or full day weekly sessions for ages 5 – 12 with flexible dates from June through August.

To apply, please submit a brief cover letter, a resume detailing your teaching experience and up to 3 class proposals for an after school class or summer camp. Proposals must include title of the class, length (after school or summer camps, half or full day), age level, objective, sample activities, and a brief description of the class. Optional - please include digital images as examples of student work or projects. If your proposal is accepted, an outline with lesson plans and activities is required.
